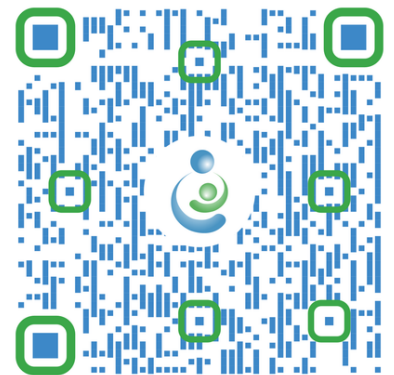
How We Offer You Support
